The Low Carbon Hub is a social enterprise that's out to prove we can meet our energy needs in a way that's good for people and good for the planet.

We develop community-owned renewable energy installations across Oxfordshire, including 50 rooftop solar arrays with schools and businesses, a hydro on the Thames and the largest community-owned ground mount solar park in the UK.

OUR PROGRAMMES

Low Carbon Hub is at the heart of a collective effort to catalyse the transition to a net-zero energy system in Oxfordshire, both through powering down to decrease energy demand and through powering up to increase renewable energy supply. Here are some of our programmes:

A domestic retrofit service for cosier, healthier, more energy efficient homes.

An energy efficiency support service to help schools in Oxfordshire carry out energy saving measures to cut carbon emissions.

These trials, part of Project LEO, will demonstrate how flexibility services can sit at the heart of a smarter, low carbon, locally balanced energy system.

Osney Lock Hydro and West Oxford Community Renewables

Grant: £1,000

By supporting the completion of the landscaping, we helped this community-owned hydro open up their site to the public. As a result more people can see renewable generation in action.

Promoting cycling in Abingdon

Grant: £500

Our grant helped purchase Hi Viz waistcoats and back-pack covers to give away as prizes for a cycling logo competition. This project promoted low-carbon travel to local schools and businesses.

LED lighting for D:Two community centre in Henley



Greener Henley

Grant: £500

Following an energy audit, the grant funded the installation of LED lights in the D:Two community centre and café, increasing the energy efficiency of the building.

WHAT SUPPORT CAN YOU ACCESS?

Apply for a Low Carbon Hub grant for your community group

You can receive a small grant of £500 once a year. We also offer a number of large £5,000 grants in a competitive process annually.

Have your say at our AGMs

Our community group partners have a shareholding in our CIC (Community Interest Company) to ensure our operation is totally transparent and is guided by those it is set up to serve. They elect one community member on our board of directors.

Energy assessments for community buildings

Nominate a community building to receive a free energy audit, giving buildings a bespoke report giving tailored advice to help reduce their energy bills and carbon footprint.
